Sztajer family

Please find information regarding Sztajer family based on witnesses of Abram Sztajer, son of Dawid Sztajer and Miriam Werebejczyk daughter of Szmuel Sztajer. More details require a search in the still existing archives in Poland – in Lodz, Czestochowa and maybe in the small towns where the members of Sztajer family used to live.

The names are written mostly in Polish transcription. Nicknames are given in parentheses, providing only the nickname is sure.

In the middle of 19-th century, in a small town Krzepice near Czestochowa lived Lajzer Sztajer with his wife Fajga (born Landsberg). They had 12 children, 5 daughters (we found the names of 3 of them only) and 7 sons. Lajzer died probably in 1878. According to family tradition the Sztajers are Cohanim.

Hersz Sztajer

Was married twice. His second wife, Miriam (Mala) Zylberberg, born Ring (born 1867, died 1920) was the mother of Lea Sztajer born Zylberberg the wife of Szmuel Sztajer (Maryla's parents). Both had children from their first marriages. They had also a common daughter Fajga (Fela), married Landsberg.

Lajzer married Ruda, born Zylberberg, daughter of his stepmother. They were the parents of Menachem (Meniek, born 1922, died 1982) and Fela (born 1920). All of them, except Menachem, were murdered in the holocaust.

Menachem changed his name from Sztajer to Arnoni. He lived after the war in Israel, USA and Holland, there he died. Married 3 times. He had 2 children. His son, Joav, born 1950, lives in Tel Aviv. His mother is Margalit (Pepa) born Fischer (1920). Joav and his mother changed their family name from Arnoni to Manor. Joav has 5
